2. Gave more information to Robert Beall Services to begin MissUtility marking of underground utilities. Utilities approved without coming onsite. Beall is now ready.

  - b. Contacted Jane Cox to get soil samples done where Beall may be digging
    - i. targeting Friday 2/24, need helpers with shovels
    - ii. Marked sample areas with yellow flags (ACE hardware \$1 and change)

## Goshen Farm Sharing Garden Committee Report for February 2017

Submitted by Bob Nestruck, Garden Committee Chairman to Lou Biondi, GFPS President and GFPS Board

### **Accomplished:**

1. Plots renewals are going well and I am actively recruiting for open plots, of which, there are 5.
2. Encouraged gardeners to tackle their overgrown plots that covered in chickweed and several have taken advantage of the good weather.
3. Inside of fence it about halfway stripped of paint. Roy is taking of the outside pickets and we will reuse to them replace rotting pickets.

### **Needs Accomplishing:**

1. Short Term:
  - a. Night vision camera to monitor nocturnal activity.
  - b. Establish educational workshops for high tunnel usage.
  - c. Compost piles need attending.
  - d. Improve Wi-Fi signal to garden.
  - e. Sift compost piles so we can add fall cleanup material.
  
2. Long Term:
  - a. Improve volunteerism in the Sharing Garden.
  - b. Install Weather station.

**Accomplished:**

1. Eagle Scout Updates:
  - A. Sean Powers contacted to sign his Eagle Scout Service Workbook for his Historic Trail with Timeline Signs Project. I signed on 2/10/17. This workbook will be sent up the Boy Scout Chain.
  - B. Steve Engel Eagle Scout Service Project Workbook, large sign at Cape St. Claire Road and the Goshen Farm driveway was also signed on 2/10/17. It will now be sent up the Boy Scout Chain for approval.
2. Worked with Broadneck High School's Enclave students several times stacking firewood and planting lettuce seeds in the greenhouse.
3. Assisted Broadneck High School's Eco Club on several Thursday afternoons with their hydroponics projects. The projects consist of growing various vegetables in six large rubber tubs with infused oxygen from small electrical pumps.
4. Sawyer Tree Service cut down the remaining 19 trees down surrounding the "Old Well."
5. Spoke with beekeeper Jenni Biondi about the potential Apiary move. Jenni informed me that the combined hive had died. We both spoke with a beekeeper who thought that the bees might have starved to death as a possible cause. I noticed that the hive had three Yellow Jackets in the top section and I reported that to Jenni.
6. Started removing the interior pickets on the north Sharing Garden Fence. This will allow for better air movement within the Garden and some of these pickets will be used to replace other broken pickets on the other fence.
7. Worked with the Electrician towards completion of his work at Goshen Farm. The electrical situation in the Farm House is much better and safer.
8. Picked up the borrowed log splitter and took it to Goshen Farm. Terry B. and I split most of the silver maple wood with the exception of some longer, large logs. Mike and Michelle have committed to purchasing the firewood. Christina Fowler will buy any remaining firewood that is not sold to the Taylors.
9. Met with Dr. J. Rango and Tressa Ballard of the Anne Arundel Community College about students working at Goshen Farm on April 25 doing various volunteer tasks. Twenty-four students will come and work on various tasks around the Farm.
10. Spoke with Laura Murry about bringing young people to Goshen Farm on Sunday April 30 to do work in the community. This may have been changed to me going to their Temple and giving some kind of talk or leading some activities at the temple.
11. Used the Gravely to cut up all the old vegetation from the Sharing Garden that had been piled to the west of the Sharing Garden. This cut up vegetation will be placed in the compost pile.
12. Purchased a replacement drive cable to speed up the Gravely mower's travel speed. Currently it moves very slowly. Have not installed it as of yet.
13. The Anne Arundel Soil Conservation District completed new specification sheets for the Wildlife Pond reflecting the new design for conveying the Farm House roof water to the pond.
14. Purchased the treated lumber for the Constellation Energy's 'Community Champions Award' for use on the Goshen Farm driveway improvements. All the materials have been purchased for this project. It is anticipated that actual installation will take place in late February or early March (weather permitting).
15. Placed various colored flags around the Farm for Miss Utility. The technician came on the 9<sup>th</sup> of February and cleared the area for electric and gas lines. A different company will check for other utilities.
16. Dropped off two inner tubes at Cape Auto who will be installing these new inner tubes on tires of the Craftsman Mower.
17. Barbara Morgan offered several old antique tools to GFPS if we wanted them. I went Saturday and picked up these tools, which will be used especially when the CSC Elementary School students come to the Farm. These will be used to demonstrate tasks that young children had to do, back in the early days of the Farm.

## Needs Accomplishing:

### Short Term:

- A. The beekeepers are still researching the need to move the hives, but no decision has been made at this time. Alternate sites are possibly south and west of the Sharing Garden or in the area behind the Tenant's Quarters nearer the pond.
- B. Assist in the decision concerning the relocation of the Goshen Farm Apiary.
- C. Install a series of wood/conveyor-belt diversions to remove runoff water at several locations on the Goshen Farm driveway. These multiple diversions will help eliminate the ruts by reducing the velocity and volume of runoff caused when rain and snow runoff flows down the driveway. This project should be completed in late February or early March, weather permitting.

### Long Term:

- a. Develop a plan to attack to control rampant growth of invasive vines that strangle the Farm's trees.
- b. Continue descriptions of planned activities listed in the Grounds Master Use Plan and continue layout of the grounds.
- c. Pursue new water well for Goshen Farm or try to tie into county water system near the Goshen Farm/Cape St. Claire Elementary School property line.
- d. Pursue composting toilets, incinerator toilets, holding tank(s) with pump outs, regular toilets connected to a septic system, or connecting to the county sewer system. Jim Morrison, of Hancock's Resolution pointed out that after their research into toilet facilities, Hancock's Resolution will be **using a large holding tank** for the bathroom effluent. He states this is a **MUCH cheaper** way to handle toilet facilities in today's world.

## Needs Approval:

Inform Jane Cox concerning the installation of the Constellation Energy Grant Diversions, moving the GF Apiary site, and the Shallow Wildlife Pond.
